



Name: **Mizen Head**

Location: 51.45, -9.819

USP: **Mizen Head, Ireland's most South-westerly Point, on the Wild Atlantic Way.**

At the end of the Mizin Peninsula, the cliffs of Mizin Head rise high above the Atlantic Ocean, where the currents meet from the west and south coasts and waves from the mid-Atlantic crash into the land.

- **Signature Key Discovery Point on the Wild Atlantic Way.**
- **Dare to cross the iconic Bridge** high above the gorge; watch for seals & heir pups in the swell below.
- **Experience the solitude of the keepers' lives** and the elemental power of the restless Atlantic where the ocean currents swirl.
- **Laugh with exhilaration into the fresh salt-laden sea air.** Be inspired by the majesty (pull) of the endless seascape and the breath-taking views.
- **Scan the ocean for whales and dolphins.** In wind, rain and gale as well as hot summer sun, the Mizin is exciting. In fog and mist, it is mysterious – a journey of discovery for the senses.
