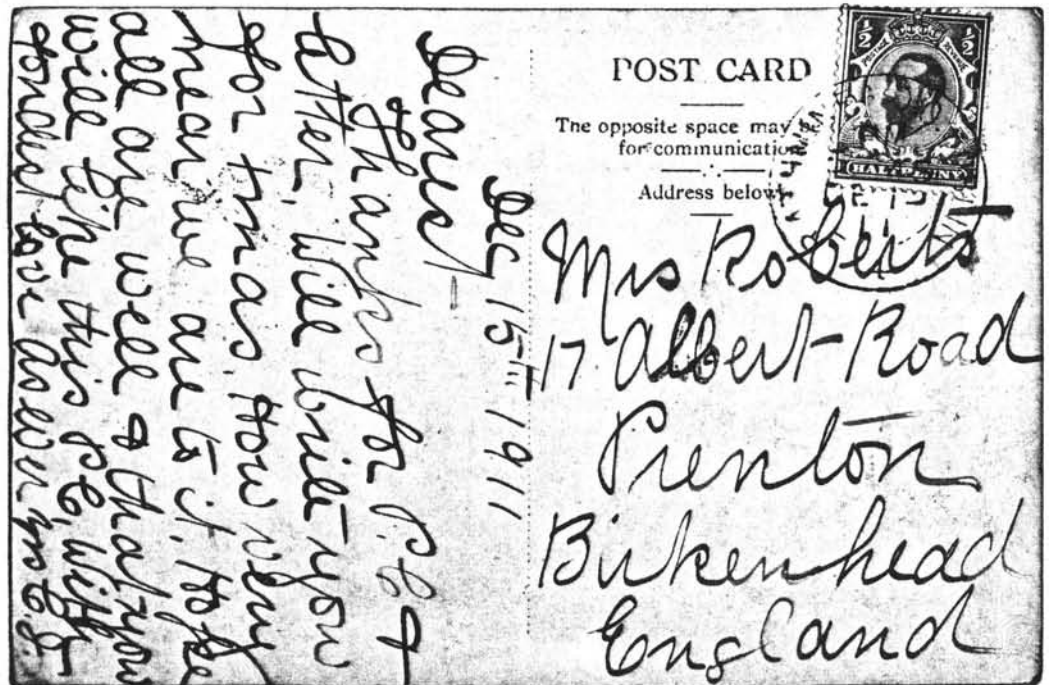


Mizen Head Bridge.

Capt. Arthur Wellesley Roberts,
almost 3 years after his death.

Mizen Head Bridge was being built in 1908 before the
shipwreck of the SS Irada, as part of the installation of a fog
signal station on Cloghane Island. They needed to join the
island to the mainland irrespective of the tides and the
weather.

"C.J." is believed to be the Liaison Bereavement Officer who
looked after the family's welfare, organising the funeral in
Ireland, etc.
