Re: Swansea-Cork Ferry 2008

Dear Capt. McCarthy,

At the Mizen Head Signal Visitor Centre we are very concerned about the withdrawal of the Swansea Cork Ferry for 2007. We would like to lobby for the return of the ferry for 2008. It is a great worry that it is not in place already and taking bookings.

This year we missed the independent visitors with their own cars from the UK. These visitors have to drive an extra 117 kms (1hr 43 mins) from Swansea to Fishguard and then 203 kms (3hrs 12 mins) from Rosslare to Cork. The journey from Rosslare to Mizen Head is 325 kms (5hrs 15 mins) instead of 130kms (2.5 hrs) from the Ferryport in Cork to Mizen Head. These figures are from www.aaireland.ie/routeplanner. The Ferryport is just beside our main artery the N71. How can this be good for tourism? It is ludicrous to say it is not damaging our trade.

Please let us know if there is anything we can do to help.
